

ENGW-105: Reflective Writing and Portfolios

This second course of a two-semester required writing course requirement for First- Year Writing. This course builds on the study of writing begun in ENGW-104 and introduces students to the habits of mind employed by seasoned writers of all professions. Additionally, this course emphasizes the conventions of academic research and stresses the selfexamination and the exploration of professional writing conventions as well as the philosophy of writing. Students will be expected to engage in discussion of contemporary issues through class discussion and to develop a digital portfolio as a capstone project for the course.
