PROS-206: Fixed Prosthodontics Lecture II

This course is the second part of the Fixed Prosthodontic Lecture series. Fixed Prosthodontics lecture II continues to hone the knowledge of Fixed Prosthodontics principles, which includes complex preparation design and laboratory procedures. Preparation for impressions, provisionals, and margin design for fixed prostheses will be emphasized. Through words and projected visual/illustration slides, the techniques that are to be performed in the laboratory will be presented. The lecture will also explain the rationale of these techniques and how they are based on sound biologic and mechanical concepts and principles. At the completion of the course series (Lecture and Lab), the student is expected to be competent in preparation design for partially edentulous patients and the related laboratory procedures and simulated exercises which serve as an introduction to the clinical practice of fixed partial denture prosthodontics. **Credits:** 1
