This initial course is arranged to provide pre-doctoral dental students with an introduction to socio-behavioral aspects of dental practice. The following issues will be discussed throughout this course: effective communication with patients and interprofessionals, core concepts of patient-centered dental care, addressing behavioral aspects of dental care, and management of vulnerable patients.
